

Do you know the details of La Habra Heights Municipal Code 7.10.10 for animal keeping in LHH?

- Did you know it is significantly more restrictive than other cities and the unincorporated parts of Los Angeles?
- Did you know if you own 1 acre or 10 acres in LHH you **can only have a maximum of 10 animals on that parcel!**
- Did you know you can only have a **total combination of 5** of the following: dogs, cats, rabbits, hens, hamsters, geckos, reptiles, or fish! How can 5 small animals and poultry/fowl be **equal to a horse in the overall total count of animals** on your property? There is no real small, medium category, no domestic pet or fowl category!

Plus, did you know the city office interprets: Your dog, cat, free range hen or horse cannot walk in any of your setbacks! Your dogs cannot greet you at your gate or your driveway; they cannot patrol your property and alert you. You have to fence them 25'-35' from your property line!! It's a fence within a fence.

The LHH Municipal Code is being interpreted by the city office of LHH the same or more restrictive than the surrounding bedroom **non- rural residential communities**. Do you want that?
